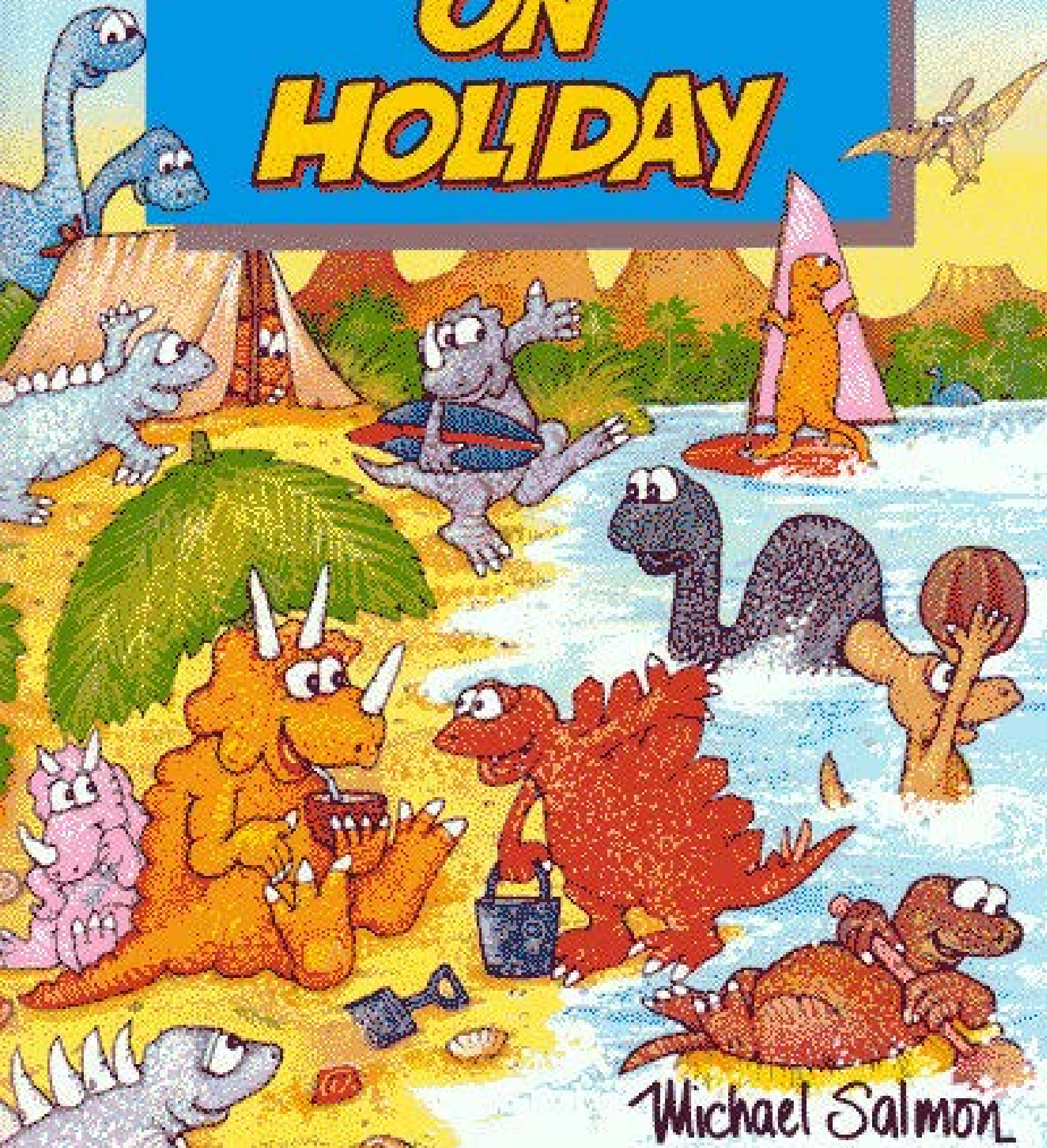


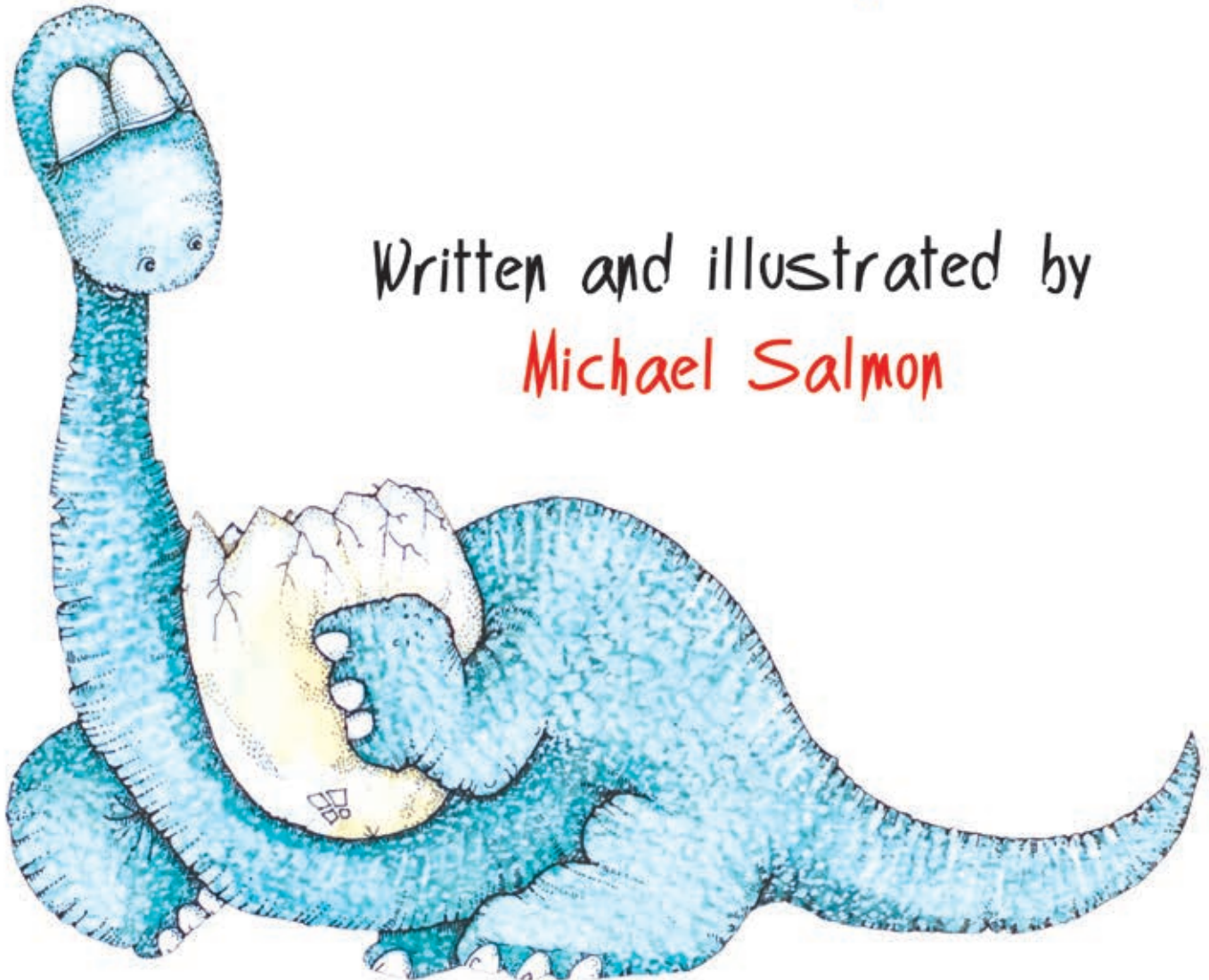

Stegga the baby Stegosaurus can't quite remember how to fold up the road map!

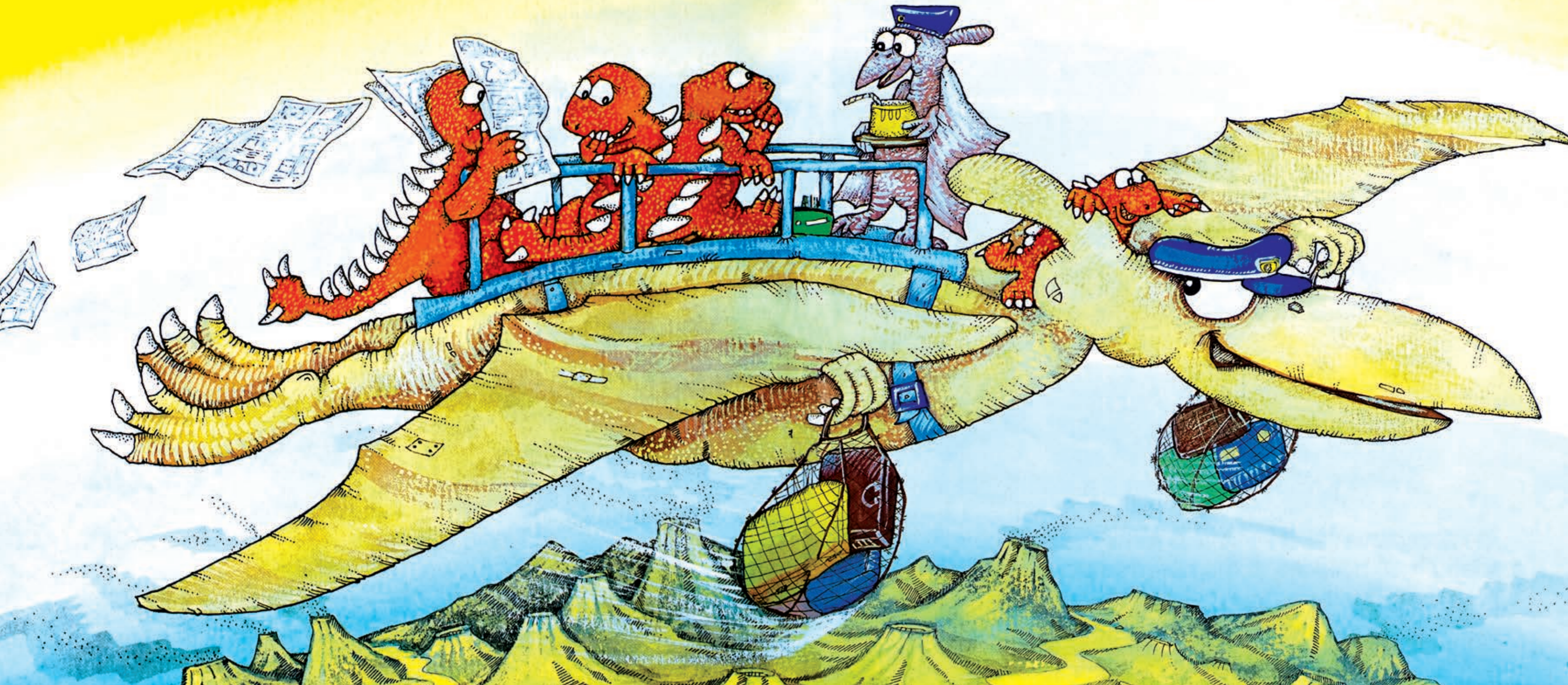

Bigteeth gives herself a beauty treatment, rubbing her scales with soft volcanic pumice stone.

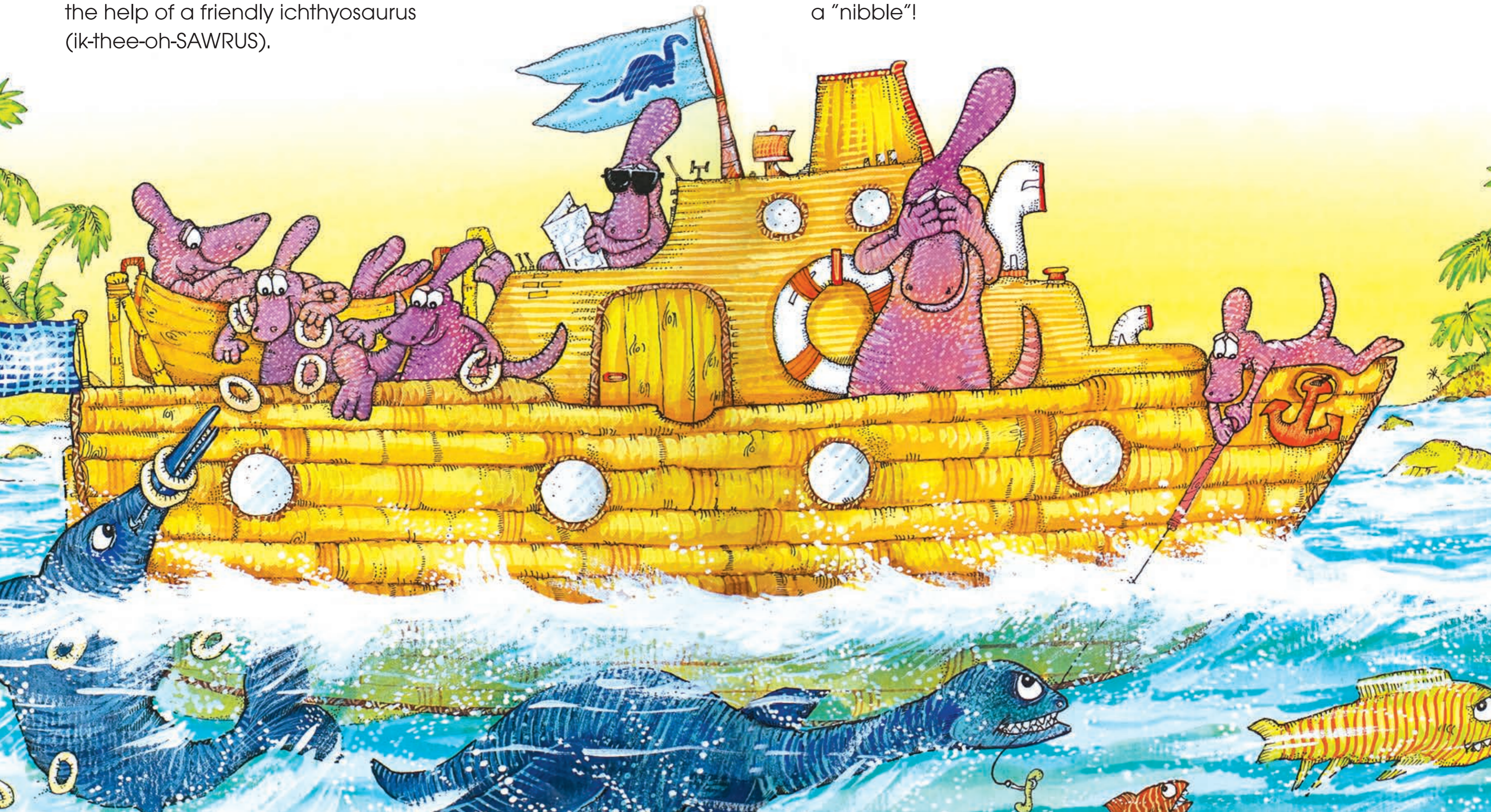
Gruzza the baby Allosaurus is ready for **his** mud bath!

Hoota the baby Parasaurolophus feels sure she's got a "nibble"!



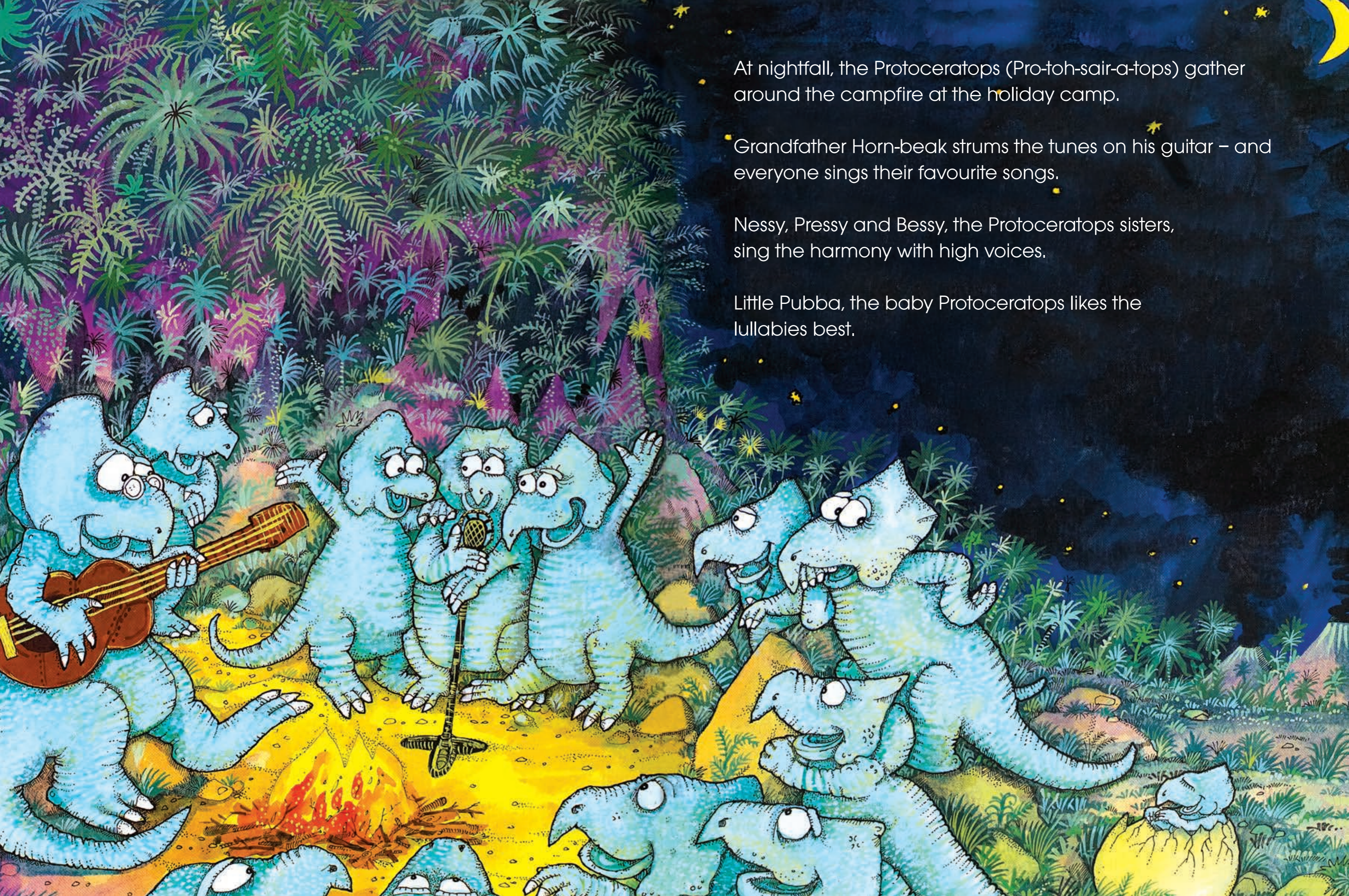


Spiky-thumb zooms down the slopes on her tree-fern skis.

Nessy, Pressy and Bessy, the Protoceratops sisters, sing the harmony with high voices.

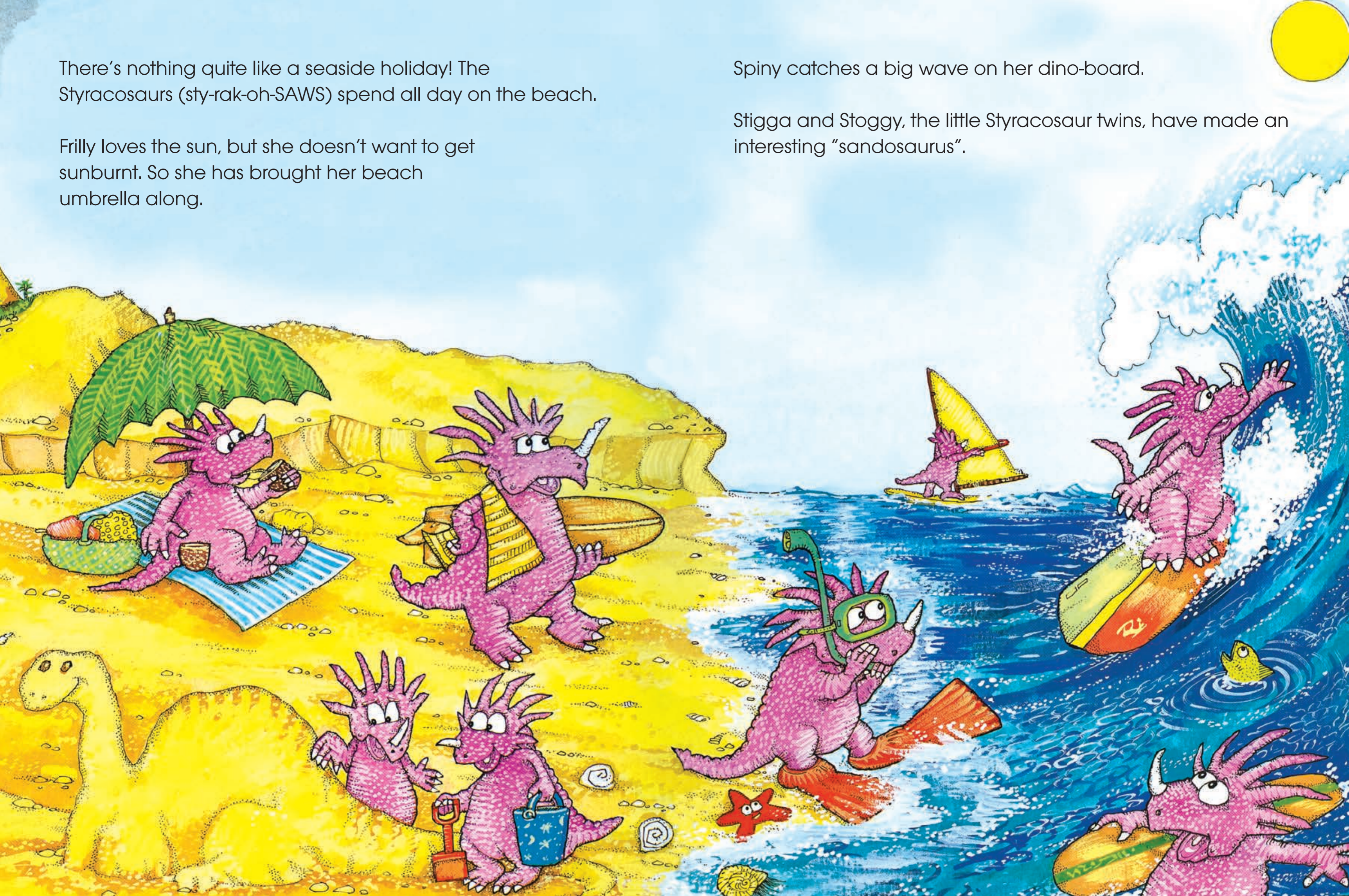
Little Pubba, the baby Protoceratops likes the lullabies best.
